

ISO/IEC Joint Technical Committee 1 Sub-Committee 37 Biometrics

Standards Australia has been asked to host the meetings of the international Biometrics standards development committee – ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 37 in 2016.

ISO/IEC JTC 1 is the Joint Technical Committee (JTC) established between the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) and the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC). JTC 1 and its subcommittees focus on the development, maintenance, promotion and facilitation of information technology (IT) standards.

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 37 is responsible for the development and maintenance of international biometric standards to support interoperability and data interchange among a diverse range of systems and applications.

As the Australian member body of ISO/IEC JTC 1, and recognised by the Australian Government as the peak standards development body in Australia, Standards Australia is pleased, subject to stakeholder support, to consider the opportunity of hosting the ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 37 Biometrics meeting in 2016.

It is anticipated that up to 120 delegates from 41 countries (including Australia, the United States, United Kingdom, Germany, France, and Italy), comprising of experts from industry, government and academia will attend the meetings, including an industry panel discussion, during the week.

Australia plays a key role in ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 37 through Standards Australia's national mirror committee, IT-032 Biometrics and Identification. This committee is responsible for establishing Australia's positions and contributions to ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 37, as well as representing Australia at international meetings.

Standards Australia provides considerable contributions and logistical support towards hosting international meetings, and we are seeking stakeholder support in the form of industry sponsorships to co-fund the ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 37 plenary meeting venue and/or social function(s).
