

FORUM: DESIGN STANDARD FOR MARINAS



AS 3962, *Design Standard for Marinas*, is a vital document for the recreational marine industry. Last published in 2001, it is in need of a revision to bring it in line with current practices.

The key outcome of the forum is to develop a clear project proposal that has broad stakeholder support, covering:

1. Explanation of current issues with AS 3962
2. Clear statement detailing the areas of the standard that will be enhanced and how
3. Demonstration of the net benefits in undertaking this work in terms of:
 - a. Public health and safety
 - b. Social and community impact
 - c. Environmental impact
 - d. Competition and innovation
 - e. Economic impact

All relevant stakeholder groups are invited to participate in discussion at the forum. Their view will assist in shaping the future of the design standard for marinas.
