Standards Australia will be hosting a forum on Tuesday 10 October 2017 from 09:30am – 12:30pm to consider and discuss a new proposal received from Ai Group for the revision of AS/NZS 3497, *Drinking water treatment units - Plumbing requirements*.

AS/NZS 3497 is maintained by the Standards Australia Technical Committee WS-027, Domestic Water Treatment Appliances. The objective of this standard is to provide manufacturers with minimum plumbing requirements for installation, design and test procedures for drinking water treatment units.

You and your nominating organisation are invited to participate. This will be an open forum to enable all interested stakeholders to raise issues for discussion, and an opportunity to clarify the scope. The draft proposal is available for consideration ahead of the event [here](#).
