# CONCRETE PLACING EQUIPMENT

TUESDAY 4 AUGUST 2015

The AS 2550 series of Australian Standards is maintained by Standards Australia committee ME-005 *Cranes* and its subcommittees. An active project to revise AS 2550.15:1994 *Cranes—Safe use, Part 15: Concrete placing equipment* has recently been cancelled because, despite several attempts to resolve concerns raised by various stakeholders, agreement on the content of the revised document could not be reached.

Standards Australia is nonetheless committed to working with industry to resolve differences and begin a new project to revise the standard within an agreed scope. Part of the proposed solution is to form a new technical committee that will focus on Australian Standards for concrete placing equipment.

The forum will include a presentation by the Concrete Pumping Association of Australia. There will be an open forum to enable other stakeholders to raise issues for discussion, and an opportunity to clarify the scope of the revised standard.
