Who's accountable for getting the most out of your digital investments?

Standards Australia committee IT-030, ICT Governance and Management, recently developed a new technical specification to provide guidance to governing bodies and executive management on effective governance of IT enabled investments. This guidance can assist in improving oversight of in-house IT enabled investments and investment in digital services.

As a result Standards Australia will be hosting a forum to mark the publication of SA/SNZ 8019, *Governance of benefits realization for IT enabled investments*, and to explore the role of the governing body throughout the business lifecycle of investments.

According to a recent Project Management Institute survey, a large number of organisations, both in the public and private sectors, have difficulty showing that IT enabled investments actually delivered the intended value. This forum will include a presentation of a relevant case study and a panel discussion involving topic experts.

The forum will also provide information to stakeholders regarding the work of IT-030 and our Australian experts in ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 40 including IT Governance, IT Service Management and IT Enabled Services Business Process Outsourcing. Views expressed during the discussion will assist in shaping the Australian and international work program.
