CO-HOSTED BY AUSTRROADS

Standards Australia, in partnership with Austroads, is holding a forum to discuss the development of an Australian Technical Specification (ATS) to complement the AS/NZS 3695 suite of standards for wheelchairs.

The proposed ATS will be called SATS 3695.3 *Wheelchairs Part 3: Requirements for designation of powered wheelchair/scooter for public transport and/or road related area use*, and will be developed by Standards Australia committee ME-067, *Assistive Technology Products for Persons with Disability*.

The purpose of this forum is to:

- Explain the background to the project and its intended outcomes; and
- Enable stakeholders to discuss the project and offer insight to issues that should be considered by the committee.

Presentations will be made by Austroads and the chairman of ME-067, Lloyd Walker. There will be an open forum to enable other stakeholders to raise issues for discussion, and an opportunity to clarify the content and intent of the proposed document.
