# ROADMAP FOR ADVANCED METERING STANDARDS

THURSDAY 16 JUNE 2016

Standards Australia will be hosting the second forum in the Roadmap for Advanced Metering Standards on Thursday 16 June 2016 as the next step in the path towards safer, more efficient and market-ready smart meters.

The Roadmap, through a series of forums in 2016, affords industry and government stakeholders the opportunity to assess the current Australian Standards and to identify relevant international standards for use in Australia. The Roadmap will ultimately work toward the development of a work program and priority list of new projects that will ensure that all Australian Standards for metering equipment are up to date and can facilitate integration into the smart grid.

Australian stakeholders came together on Thursday 3 March 2015 at the first forum of Standards Australia's Roadmap for Advanced Metering Standards. The forum participants considered the key standards-related issues regarding the roll out of smart meters and agreed to focus their activities in four work streams:

1. Safety;
2. General Requirements, Tariff & Load Control;
3. Accuracy & Protocol; and
4. Acceptance & Dependability.

The focused work on safety has already commenced with the first meeting of Standards Australia's technical committee EL-011, Metering Equipment, which took place on 19 April 2016. The three other work streams undertaking research and investigative work held discussions on 20 April to consider updating Australian Standards for metering relating to general requirements, accuracy and protocol, and acceptance and dependability.

The second forum will provide an update on the work of EL-011 on the modified adoption of IEC 62052.31. Reports from the three other work streams will also be presented.

The roadmap is co-resourced by key proponents including Vector, Origin, the Energy Networks Association, Landis+Gyr and EDMI together with Standards Australia.

All relevant stakeholder groups are welcome to participate in the Roadmap. Participants will have the opportunity to join the discussion after the presentations.
