## **Submissions Open: Communications Cabling Standards**

On 7 April Standards Australia hosted a round table regarding communications cabling standards.

The purpose of the round table was to discuss the direct text adoption of ISO/IEC 14543.3 (Parts 1–6), *Communication layers – Network based control*. Standards Australia recorded the various perspectives of stakeholders at the event which will contribute to Standards Australia's forward plan relating to communications cabling.

To ensure that all relevant stakeholders have an opportunity to formally communicate their views on communications cabling standards, Standards Australia will accept written submissions regarding communications cabling with the following terms of reference:

- The relevance to Australia of ISO/IEC 14543.3 (Parts 1–6)
- Adoption of ISO/IEC 14543.3 (Parts 1–6) as Australian Standards or Australian Technical Specifications
- Scope of work undertaken by CT-001 including as Australian mirror committee to ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 25, Interconnection of information technology equipment, and the adoption of ISO/IEC 14543.3 (Parts 1–6)
- Future management of building automation standards in Australia

Submissions should be addressed to 'Standards Australia Communications Cabling Submission' and sent by email to [nsm@standards.org.au](mailto:nsm@standards.org.au) before close of business **Monday 16 May 2016**. Submissions should be kept to a maximum of two pages.

Standards Australia will review and assess all submissions in accordance with our policies and procedures. The round table and submissions will shape the forward plan which will be made available to stakeholders after submissions are received.
